On August 14th, 2025, School of Design hosted the Mission Tiranga Treasure Hunt as part of the 79th Independence Day celebrations.

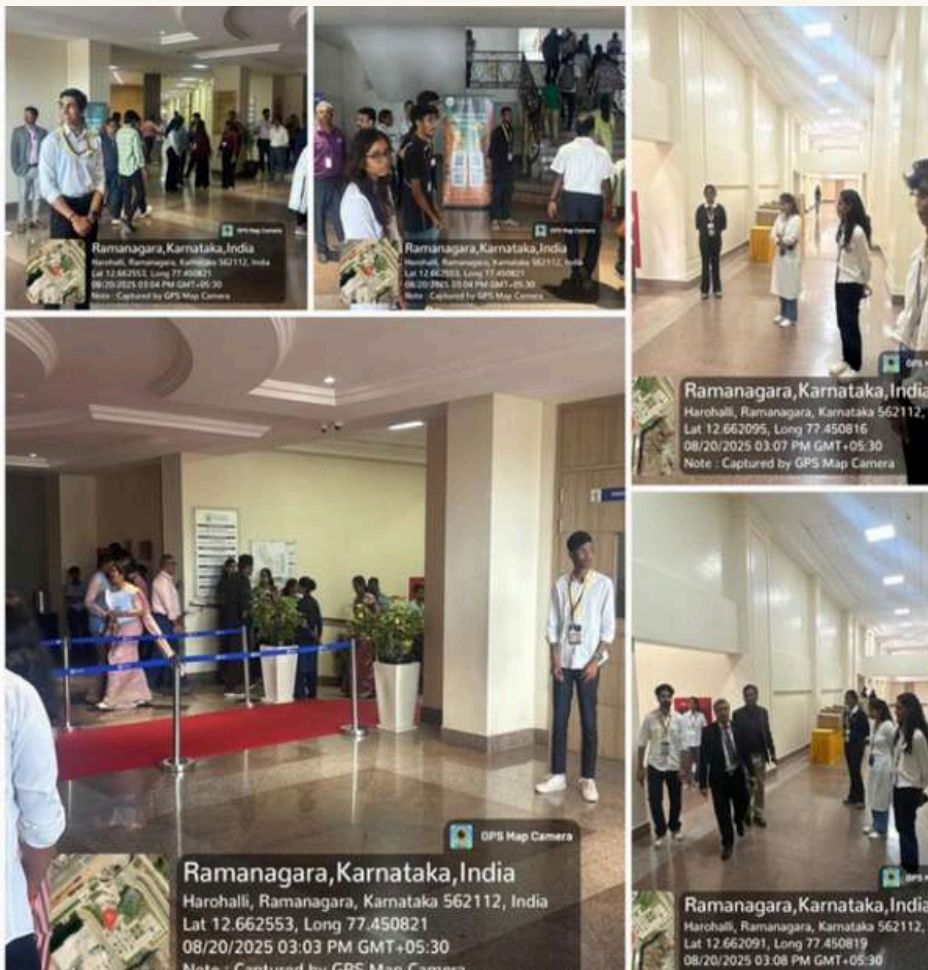

This initiative empowered students with industry-relevant skills, bridging classroom learning with real-world application.



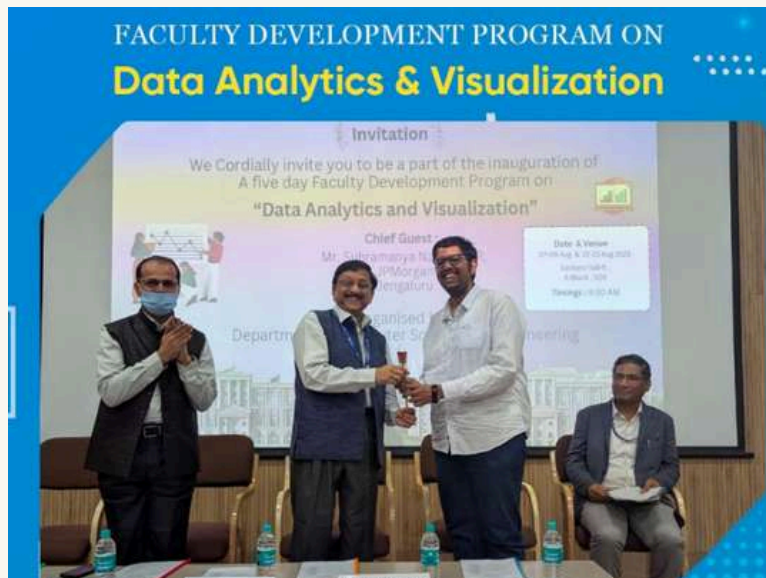


Faculty Development Program

The session focused on two highly specialized and critical areas in cancer care: Bone Marrow Transplantation and Management of Neutropenic Patients. These topics were chosen to provide students with real-world insights into advanced nursing practices and patient care strategies.

The program commenced with a warm welcome and introduction of alumni guest speakers and highlighted the importance of alumni engagement in professional development. Such interactions help bridge the gap between classroom learning and clinical application.



Alumni speaker Mr. Akash Manganure, who is working as a Team Leader with the Department of Oncology, Manipal Hospitals, led the first session with a comprehensive presentation on Bone Marrow Transplantation. His session provided students with a clear understanding of the complexities involved in transplant procedures and the multidisciplinary approach required for successful outcomes.

The next Alumni speaker Ms. Pooja, who works as a staff nurse, Department of Oncology, Manipal Hospitals, Bangalore during her insightful session shared details on the care of neutropenic patients, a critical aspect of oncology nursing. Her practical examples and case-based approach helped students grasp the nuances of managing immunocompromised patients.



To honor the contributions of the speakers, Mrs. Julice Varughese, Head of Department and Associate Professor, presented certificates of appreciation and tokens of gratitude. She acknowledged the value of alumni involvement in shaping the next generation of nursing professionals and thanked the speakers for their time and expertise.

Our students pursuing 3rd semester B.Sc. Nursing gained information about enhanced understanding of specialized oncology procedures. They got exposure to real-life clinical scenarios and nursing responsibilities and motivation to pursue excellence in patient care and professional growth. The talk was well-received and sparked meaningful discussions among students, reinforcing the importance of continuous learning and alumni mentorship.
