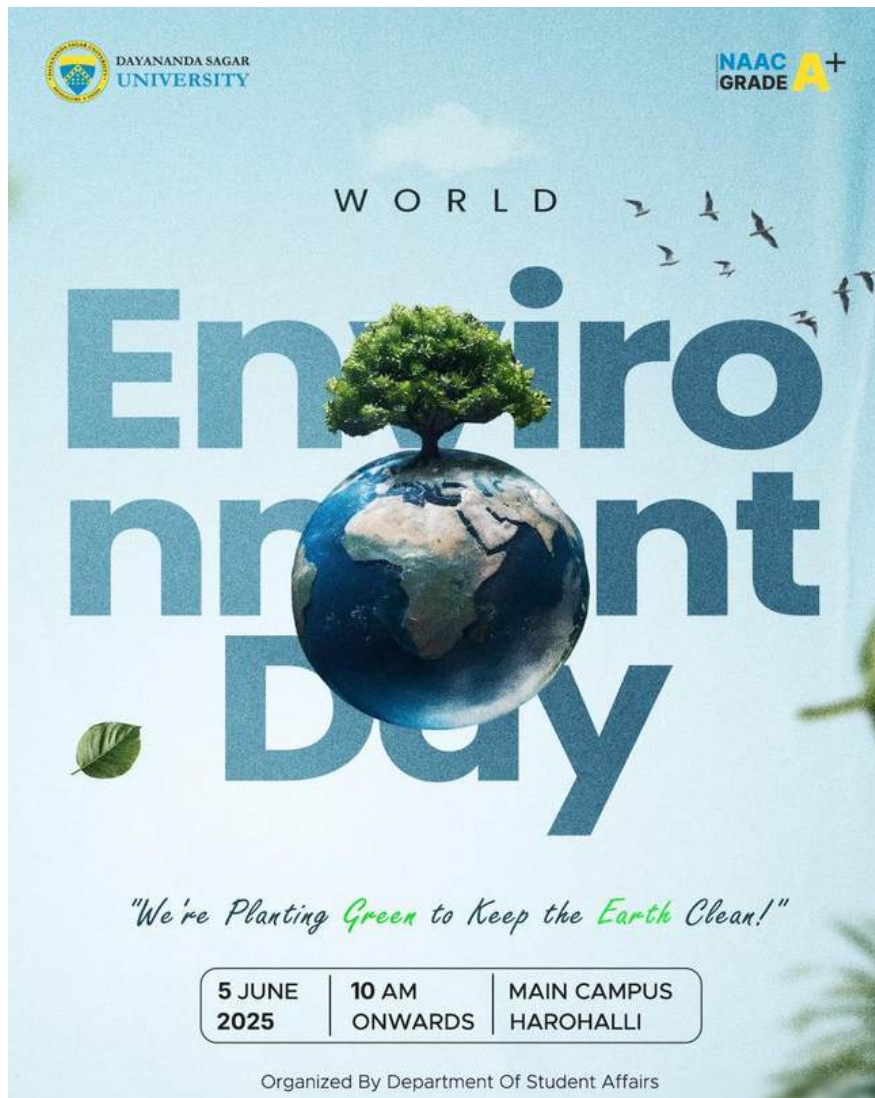

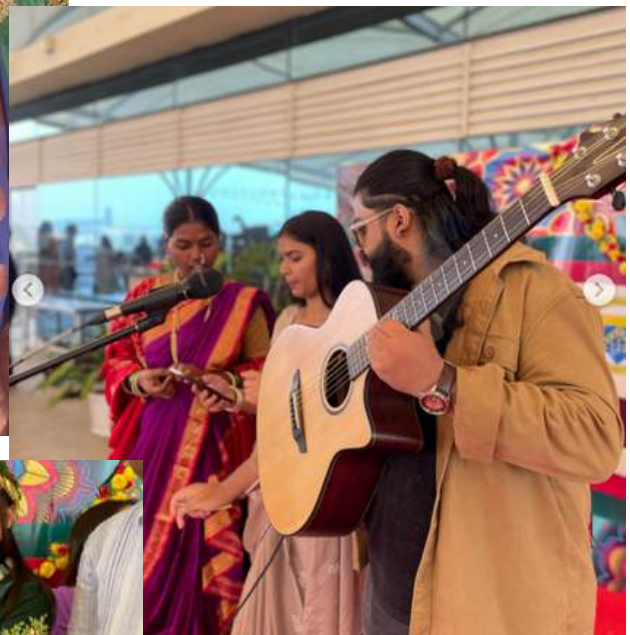
# BLOOD DONATION CAMP

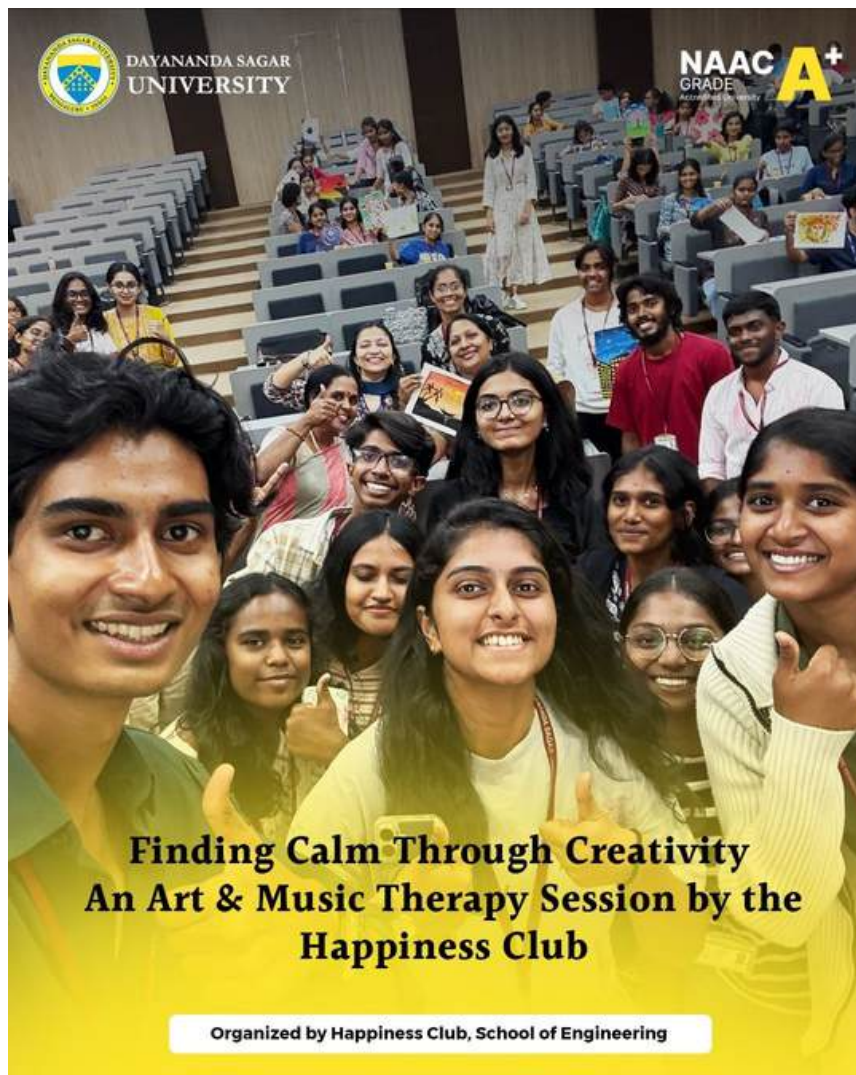

# DSU- COLLEGE OF JOURNALISM AND MASS COMMUNICATION INDUSTRY VISIT



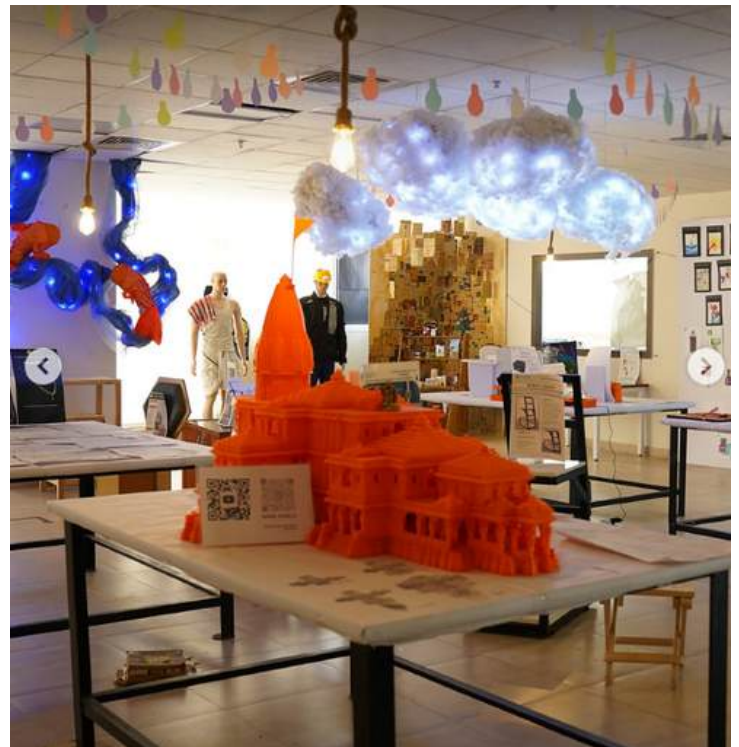
Students from DSU – CJMC visited the studio and recording room at News First TV. They explored and witnessed live anchoring, AR graphics, and the buzz of a real newsroom.
