Hands-on Learning with Industry Expert

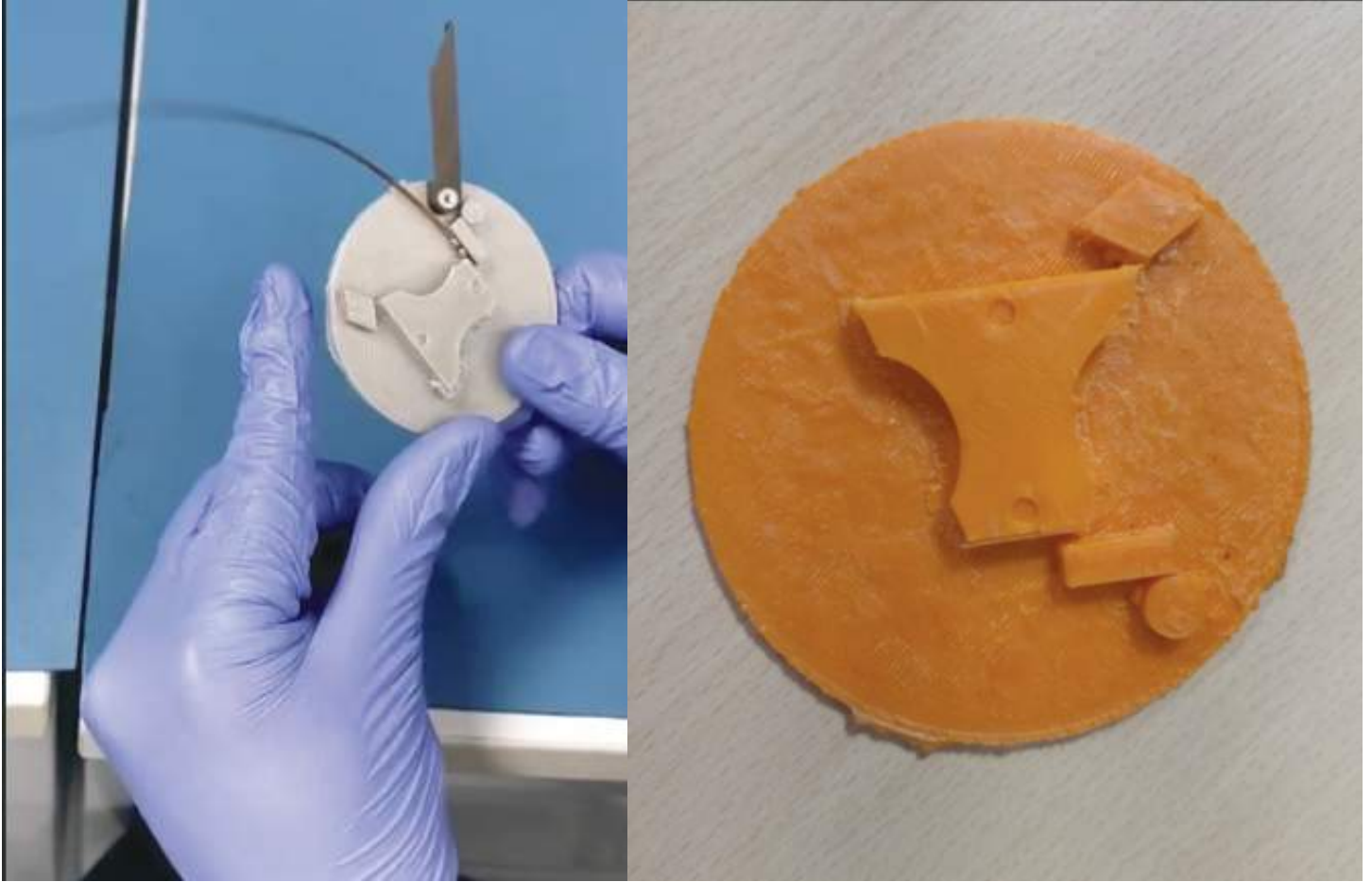
