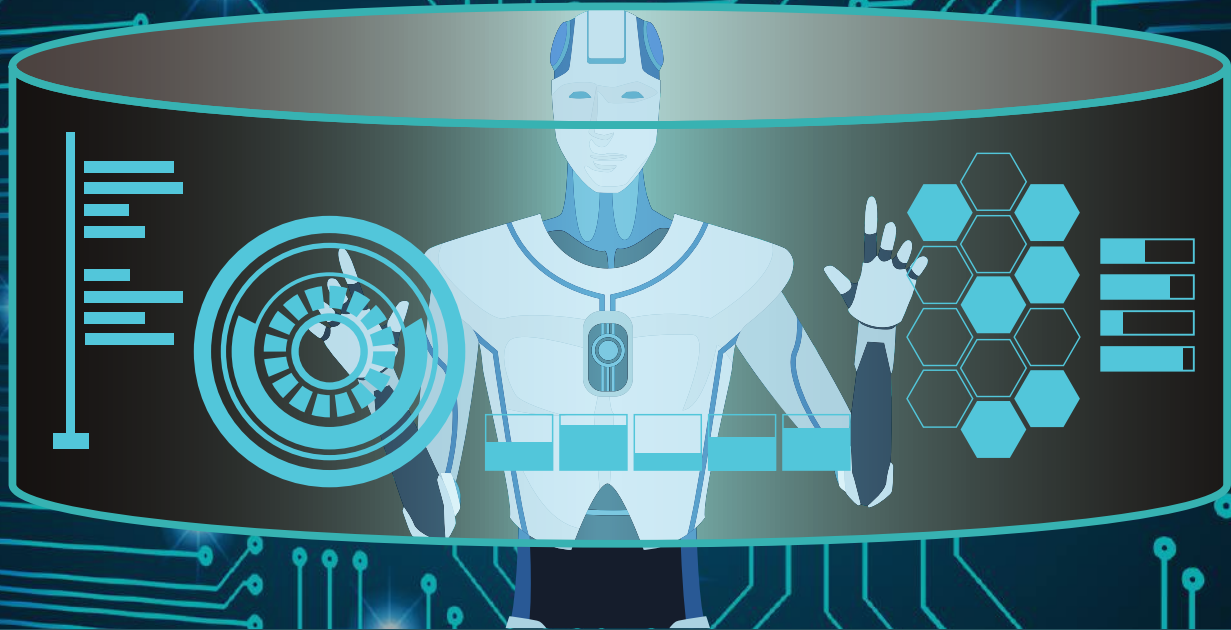

The Department of Computer Science & Engineering (CSE) at Dayananda Sagar University (DSU), established in 2015, is one of the University's flagship departments, committed to academic excellence, cutting-edge research, innovation, and industry-driven education. The department offers B.Tech in Computer Science & Engineering, M.Tech in Computer Science & Engineering, and Ph.D. programmes in Computer Science & Engineering and allied disciplines. These programmes are designed to equip students with strong theoretical foundations, hands-on technical expertise, interdisciplinary thinking, and research capabilities to address the challenges of the digital and AI-driven era.

The department is supported by a highly qualified faculty comprising 43 doctorates and 25 faculty members pursuing doctoral research, actively engaged in teaching, research, consultancy, and innovation. Faculty expertise spans a wide spectrum of emerging domains, including Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Generative AI, Large Language Models (LLMs), Agentic AI, Data Science, Computer Vision, AR/VR/XR, High Performance Computing, GPU Computing, Embedded Systems, Cyber Security, Blockchain, Internet of Things (IoT), Cloud Computing, Big Data Analytics, Image & Video Processing, 5G Mobile Networks, and other frontier technologies.

A hallmark of Dayananda Sagar University's AI-First initiative is its AI-Enabled AR/VR/XR Center of Excellence (CoE), a state-of-the-art immersive innovation hub that enables students and researchers to design, develop, and deploy next-generation spatial computing applications. The center is equipped with advanced immersive technologies, including Meta Quest 3, HTC Vive Pro 2, Varjo XR-4, AI-powered workstations, motion capture systems, holographic displays, immersive visualization Displays, NVIDIA Omniverse, Unity, Unreal Engine, and advanced simulation platforms. The CoE supports multidisciplinary research, industry-sponsored projects, startup incubation, digital twins, metaverse applications, healthcare simulation, industrial training, and AI-powered immersive experiences.

The department also leverages DSU's Academic AI Factory, powered by NVIDIA DGX Blackwell GPU infrastructure, providing students and researchers access to world-class computing resources for AI model development, Generative AI, Large Language Models, High Performance Computing, scientific computing, computer vision, robotics, and advanced research. This AI ecosystem enables students to gain practical exposure to enterprise-scale AI technologies while fostering innovation and collaborative research.

The department houses modern laboratories and innovation facilities that provide experiential learning across core and emerging technologies. Students benefit from hands-on exposure through specialized laboratories in AI, Data Science, Networks, Cyber Security, Cloud Computing, Embedded Systems, IoT, Software Engineering, AR/VR/XR, and High Performance Computing, ensuring they are industry-ready upon graduation.

Beyond the curriculum, the department regularly organizes Value-added courses, Professional certifications, Hackathons, coding competitions, innovation challenges, workshops, faculty development programmes, symposiums, conferences, technical exhibitions, and research seminars, nurturing creativity, entrepreneurship, and lifelong learning.

Stand with science” on the occasion of world health day on 7th April 2026 at 10:45 AM in A Block LH-5. The session featured Dr. Priyadarisini N J, Associate Professor, Department of Community Medicine, CDSIMER, Dayananda Sagar University (DSU) as the Distinguished Speaker. The session conducted on the occasion of World Health Day 2026, in line with the theme advocated by the World Health Organization, highlighted the significance of science-driven approaches to health and well-being. She emphasized the need to rely on scientific evidence for making informed lifestyle and healthcare decisions, fostering trust in medical guidance, and promoting community-wide awareness.



The talk encouraged participants to actively support the theme “Together for Health, stand with Science” by adopting responsible and informed health practices. The session also focused on practical aspects of maintaining a healthy lifestyle, particularly diet and mental well-being. Detailed insights were provided on age-wise and gender-wise nutritional requirements, stressing the importance of balanced intake of proteins, vitamins, and essential minerals for overall growth and immunity. Additionally, she addressed the issue of exam-related stress among students and suggested effective methods such as meditation, yoga, and relaxation techniques to reduce tension and improve concentration. These strategies aimed to help students maintain both physical and mental health, ensuring better academic performance and overall well-being.

Finally, she emphasized the importance of mental health and overall well-being by highlighting the need for emotional balance in daily life. She also discussed how maintaining a healthy lifestyle through regular physical activity, proper sleep, and mindful habits can significantly improve mental resilience. Practical coping tools such as time management, relaxation techniques, positive thinking, and mindfulness were suggested to handle stress effectively. The role of social support from family, friends, and peers was also underscored as a key factor in overcoming challenges, building confidence, and fostering a supportive environment for both personal and academic growth.

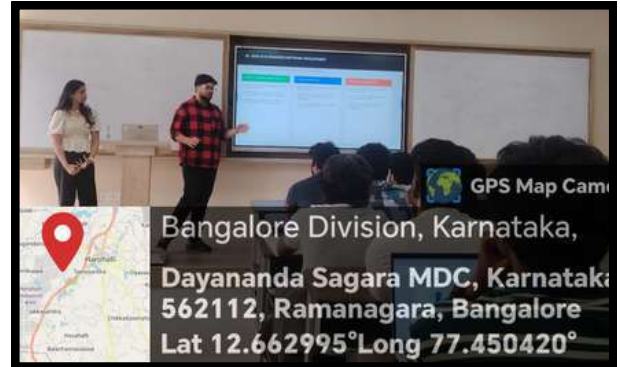

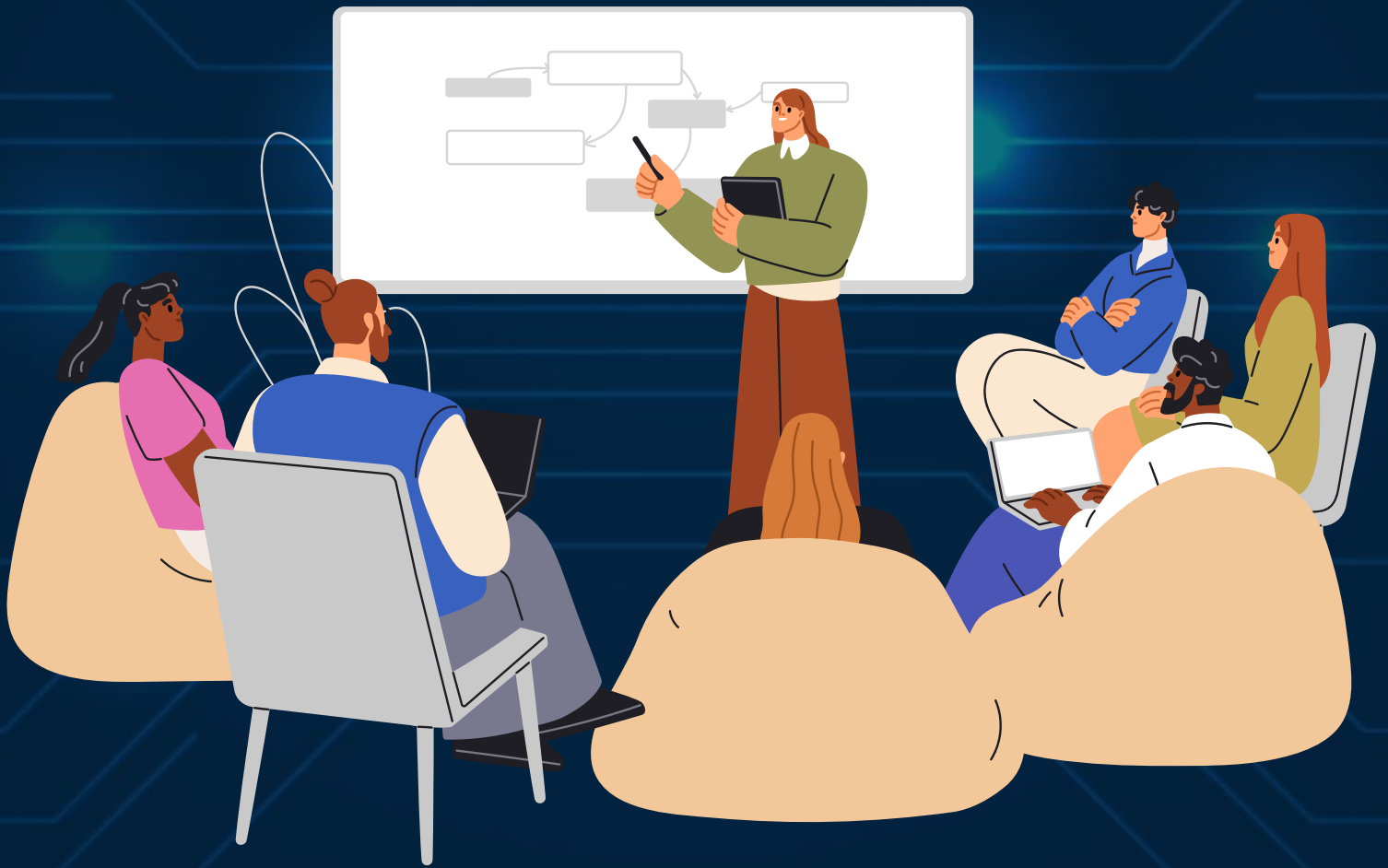

The session provided valuable insights into emerging trends at the intersection of artificial intelligence and healthcare, fostering awareness among researchers, academicians, medical professionals, and students from diverse interdisciplinary backgrounds. Participants actively engaged in discussions on the future prospects, opportunities, and challenges of integrating AI technologies into pharmaceutical research and clinical practice. The lecture successfully underscored the importance of leveraging AI-powered computational tools to drive innovation in healthcare and encouraged interdisciplinary collaboration for addressing complex biomedical challenges.

The Department of Computer Science & Engineering, School of Engineering, Dayananda Sagar University organized The Drone Workshop Fundamentals to Flight is a beginner-friendly, hands-on workshop hosted by the Entrepreneurship Cell on 13th April, 2026. The workshop was aimed at igniting curiosity about unmanned aerial systems and fostering practical problem-solving skills among students.

Participants explored the complete anatomy of a drone from its core frame and propulsion components to advanced flight controllers. The day covered seven structured modules: drone basics and real-world applications, components and flight mechanics, roll-pitch-yaw control fundamentals, Pixhawk 2.4.8 overview, Mission Planner calibration workflow, pre-flight checks and safety basics, and a live troubleshooting and controlled flight demonstration.

The workshop was conducted and saw enthusiastic participation from students across engineering disciplines. Participants assembled drone frames hands-on, configured flight controllers, calibrated transmitters, and witnessed a live controlled flight demo gaining a comprehensive end-to-end understanding of modern drone systems.

The Department of Computer Science & Engineering at Dayananda Sagar University successfully Conducted Techflix Season 2: CYBERANARCHY CTF on 15th April 2026 at the School of Engineering, as a 3-hour cybersecurity wargame. The event began with an introductory session where participants were briefed about the platform, rules, scoring system, and sample challenges.

Participants competed in teams of 3 members, solving challenges across multiple domains including Web Exploitation, Cryptography, Reverse Engineering, Digital Forensics, and Binary Exploitation. The challenges were inspired by real-world scenarios and ranged from beginner to advanced levels.

The competition featured a live leaderboard, real-time scoring, and dynamic difficulty-based challenges. Additional features such as first-solve bonuses, progressive hints, and a dynamic threat map enhanced the overall experience.

The challenge set included a variety of problems such as:

- Decoding encrypted data using Base64, Caesar Cipher, and multi-layer encryption
- Exploiting web vulnerabilities like SQL Injection, JWT bypass, and hidden endpoints
- Recovering hidden data from files and memory dumps using forensic techniques
- Reverse engineering programs to extract keys and analyze authentication logic
- Performing OSINT-based investigations using publicly available information

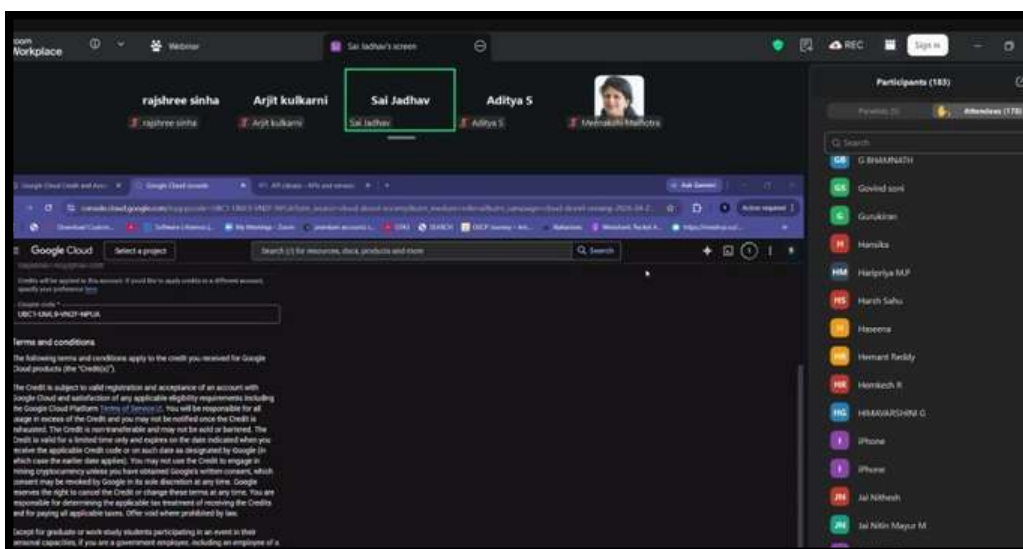
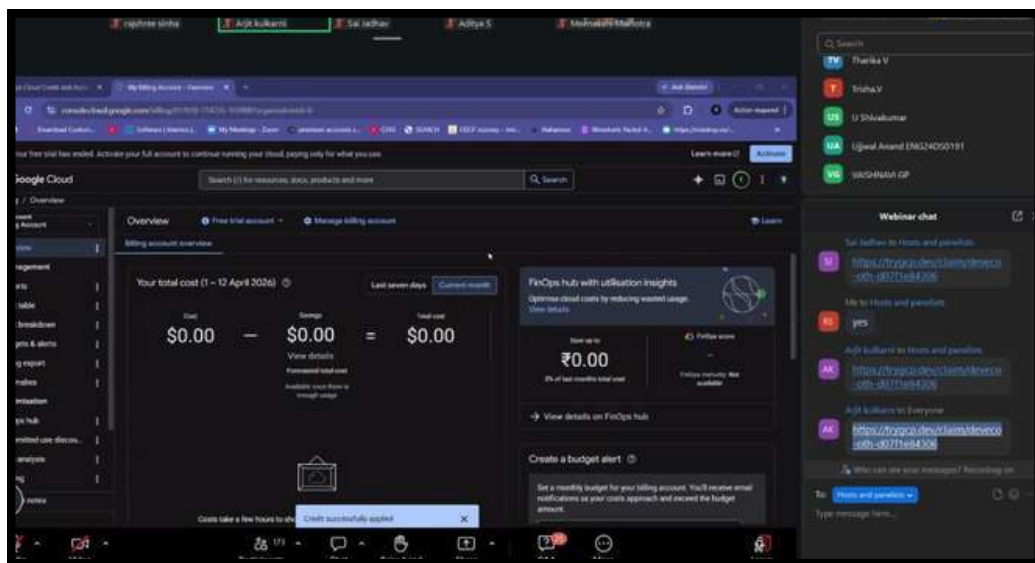
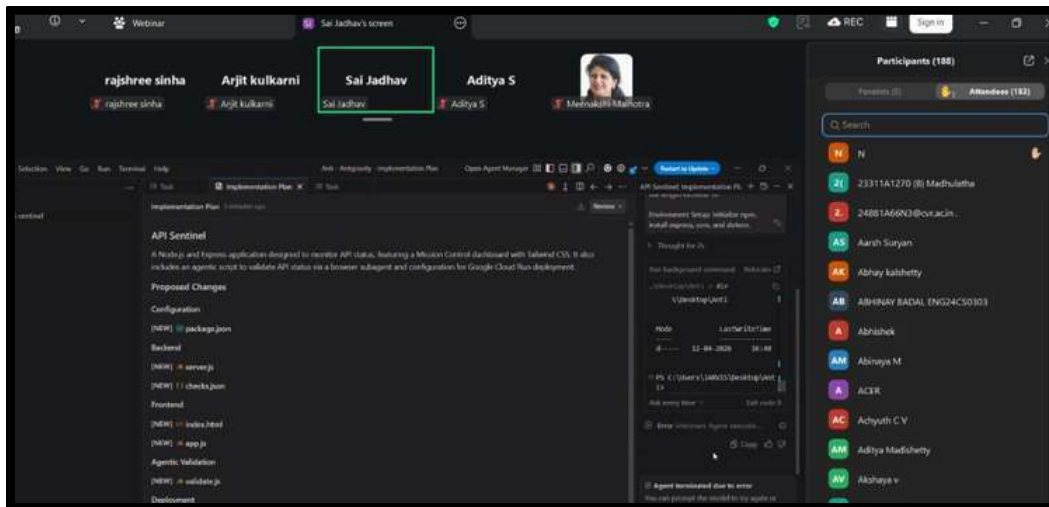

Conducted as a precursor to Techflix Season 2, the workshop was held in an online mode from 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM, providing students with an opportunity to explore cutting-edge advancements in artificial intelligence and cloud-based application development. Build with AI is a free, hands-on campus bootcamp series organized by Reskill in partnership with Google, touring 50+ college campuses across India. Designed for engineering students and early-career developers, the workshop brings together participants for an intensive one-day session led by Google Developer Experts – where the only goal is to walk out having built and deployed a real AI application. Over the course of four hours, attendees learnt to build autonomous AI agents using Google AI Studio and Google Antigravity, integrate the Gemini API, and deploy a live application on Google Cloud Run with no prior AI experience required. The curriculum skips the theory and goes straight to production-grade development: prompt engineering, agentic workflows, and cloud deployment, all hands-on.

Participants earn an official certificate, receive free \$5 Google Cloud credits, and get access to a global community of AI builders.

More than just a technical workshop, Build with AI was designed to give the next generation of developers a real taste of agent-first development, the kind used by professional engineering teams in the energy of a live, in-person setting. The number of participants registered was 545 and 210 participants joined the online session

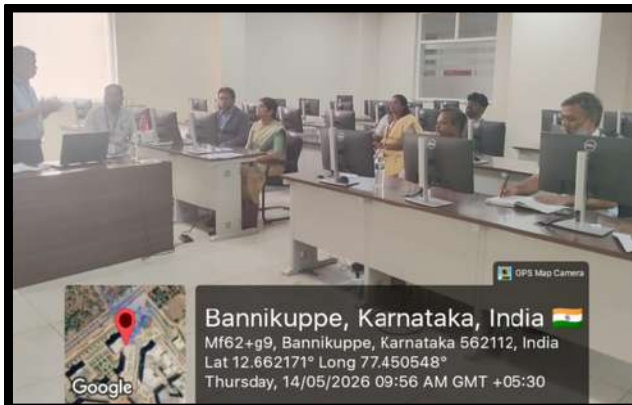

## BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING

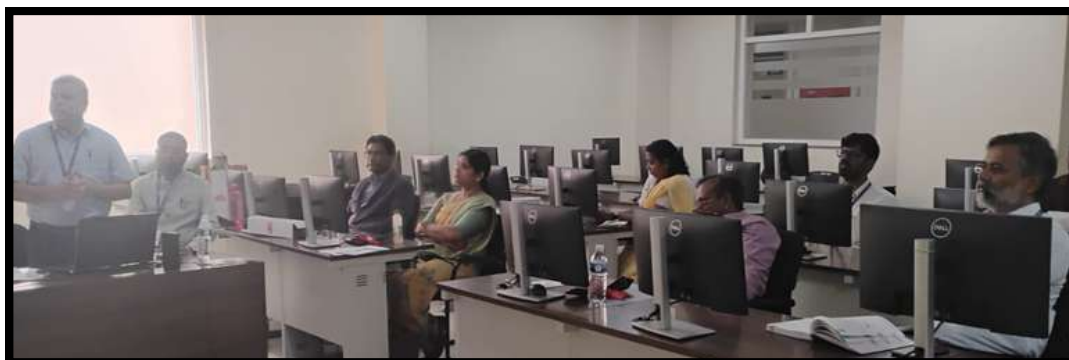
