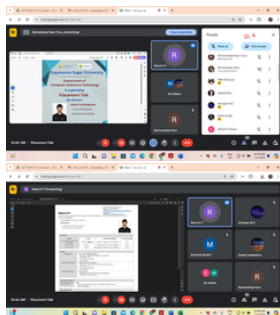
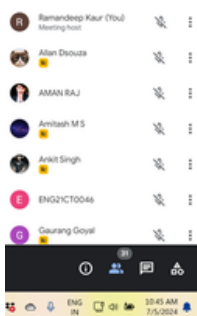
Events: Department Activities

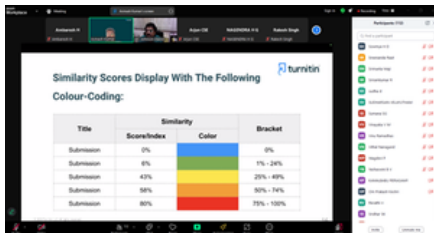
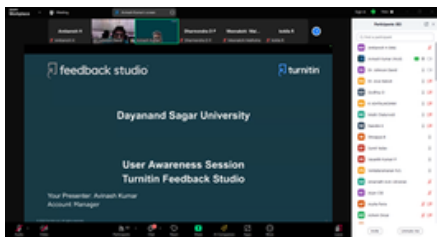


Session on effective utilization of "Turnitin Plagiarism Detection Tool"
