ABSTRACTS SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstracts are invited that:

- Abstracts with latest research and original scientific data including Original studies/Experimental studies/Randomised Controlled Trials, Systematic/Narrative reviews and Meta-analysis will be considered for further procedure. Submission with pending results and study protocols will not be accepted.
- Address new and unique developments in practice, theory, education, management, policy and resources.
- Describe innovative ways in which established methods have been adapted to meet the changing needs of practice.

Abstract Submission Requirements:

- The authors presenting paper must be registered with full payment for the conference.
- The proposals and presentations must be made in English language.
- Abstracts for the scientific sessions must be submitted in PDF format via the QR code or the conference email ID. Abstract format other than PDF shall not be accepted.
- Notification of outcome of the submission will be emailed to the person who submits the abstract on the respective link and is responsible for informing all the authors of the abstract.
- Abstracts must have a complete status by the deadline mentioned above or the abstracts will not be considered for the scientific session program. Extension of the submission date shall not be granted.
- One presenter per paper rule has to be followed. Only one author may present the abstract and if no author is available on-site the abstract shall be withdrawn. Certificate will be issued only for presenting author.
- Abstract shall contain the registration number and the title. Exclude mentioning the college name, guide name and the presenter names.
- All presentations including research on humans (patients, carers, students, faculty, staff, colleagues) or animals must provide proof of evidence that the research was carried out under ethical grounds with institutional ethical committee letter/number.
- The scheduling of all the presentations will be determined by the scientific Coordinator and any request on change in date and time shall not be considered.
- No changes shall be entertained once the abstract is submitted whereas exception will only be allowed with written permission of the chair of the scientific coordinator.



- All decisions made by the scientific coordinators are final and No honorarium, fee or payment of expenses will be paid to presenters.

Abstract Data:

- The proposals and presentations must be made in English language with accurate grammar and spelling suitable for publication.
- Authors should not split the data to create several abstracts from one. If splitting is found prior to the presentation, scores of related abstracts will be reduced.
- Multiple abstracts may not be submitted for one study unless substantially different research questions are being addressed in each abstract.
- Proof read abstracts carefully to avoid deadline mistakes.
- The abstract will be published exactly in Souvenir as it has been submitted.

Abstract Title:

- Must have a short and specific title with no more than 20 words, containing no abbreviations or inflammatory language.
- The title should not indicate the results of the research that will be presented.

Abstract Text:

- The identifiable sections like: Introductions, Aims and Objectives, Research question/Hypothesis Need for the study, Methods, Results and Conclusion should be followed in the presentation. These fields can be edited or deleted as appropriate for your abstract.
- Only minimum use of Standard Abbreviations is permitted in abstract.
- Objectives must be defined briefly unless included in the title. A brief statement of methods must be made pertinent. The findings of the research must be explained in detail with supporting conclusion. Do not begin sentences with numeral and do not include the credits and grant support.
- Do not include names and personal information of any subject recruited in the study.
- Maximum limit of words for abstract shall be 250 which included text and graphics excluding title and the registration number. All graphics (figures) should be in jpg format with maximum width up to 440 pixels.
- References should be mentioned at the last.

A Platform presentation will be 08 minutes oral presentation of a paper followed by 2 minutes of question answer time.



POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Specifications for Poster Presentations:

- Poster displays will be limited to one side of a 4 foot by 8-foot tack board. The recommended poster size is 4 feet (length) by 3 feet (width) (48 inches by 36 inches).
- Be sure to include the abstract title and Registration number.
- It is recommended that you hand-carry your poster to the conference, using tubular packaging or a portfolio case.
- Costs associated with creating and shipping the poster display will be the responsibility of the authors. Velcro (easiest to use), pushpins, or thumbtacks will be provided to mount your poster.
- Refer to your acceptance letter and/or the final conference program for the time and location of your poster session and set-up time.
- The designated poster presenter (author or co-author) must be present at the assigned space during the designated time to discuss the work presented.
- References should be mentioned at the scanned and converted in QR Code/ Can be mentioned at the end.
