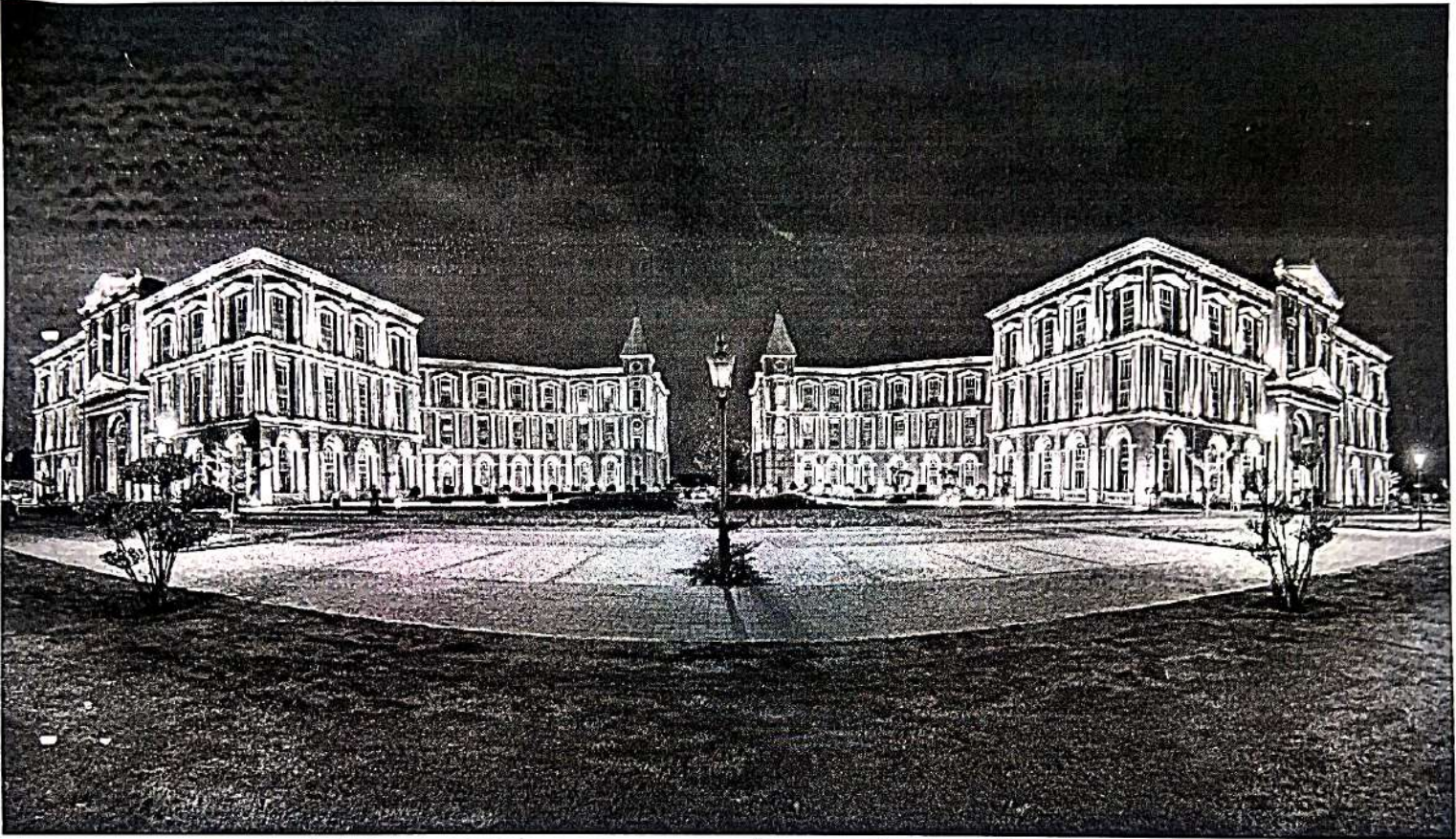

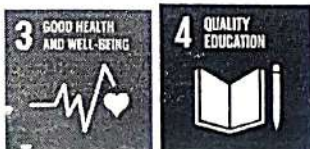

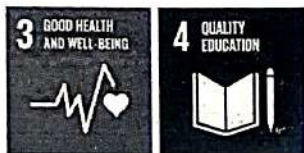

The session was delivered by Dr. Chayya Verma (PT), PhD, Ex-Principal plus Professor & Head, Physiotherapy School & Center, Topiwala National Medical College, Mumbai.

The webinar aimed to provide clinical insights and evidence-based approaches in the rehabilitation of traumatic brachial plexus injury. The session witnessed active participation from physiotherapy students and professionals across different states of India.

2. Objective of the Event

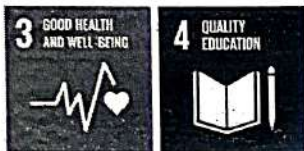
- To enhance knowledge regarding traumatic brachial plexus injury (BPI) and its rehabilitation.

4. Brief Description of the event

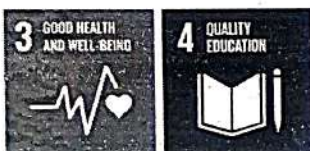
The webinar titled "A Practical Approach to Rehabilitation in Traumatic Brachial Plexus Injury" was successfully organized by the College of Physiotherapy, School of Health Sciences, Dayananda Sagar University on 03 March 2026 from 09:30 AM to 11:00 AM. The session was delivered by the esteemed resource person Dr. Chayya Verma (PT), PhD, Ex-Principal plus Professor & Head, Physiotherapy School & Center, Topiwala National Medical College, Mumbai.

The session focused on providing a practical and clinical perspective on the rehabilitation of patients with traumatic brachial plexus injury (BPI). Dr. Verma shared her extensive clinical experience and explained the anatomy and mechanism of brachial plexus injuries, common causes, and the importance of early assessment and physiotherapy intervention. She emphasized the role of comprehensive clinical evaluation, functional assessment, and appropriate rehabilitation planning for improving patient outcomes.

During the webinar, various physiotherapy management strategies were discussed, including muscle re-education, strengthening exercises, range of motion exercises, sensory re-education, and functional training. Dr. Verma also highlighted the importance of multidisciplinary rehabilitation, patient motivation, and long-term follow-up in the recovery process. Real-life clinical cases and practical examples were presented, which helped participants understand the application of theoretical concepts in actual clinical settings.

The session was highly interactive, with participants actively engaging in the question-and-answer discussion, which allowed clarification of clinical doubts and deeper understanding of BPI rehabilitation. Overall, the webinar provided valuable learning opportunities and enhanced the clinical knowledge and practical skills of physiotherapy students and professionals.

Participants completed a pre-webinar form, post-webinar assessment form, and feedback form, and the responses indicated a very positive learning experience for the attendees.

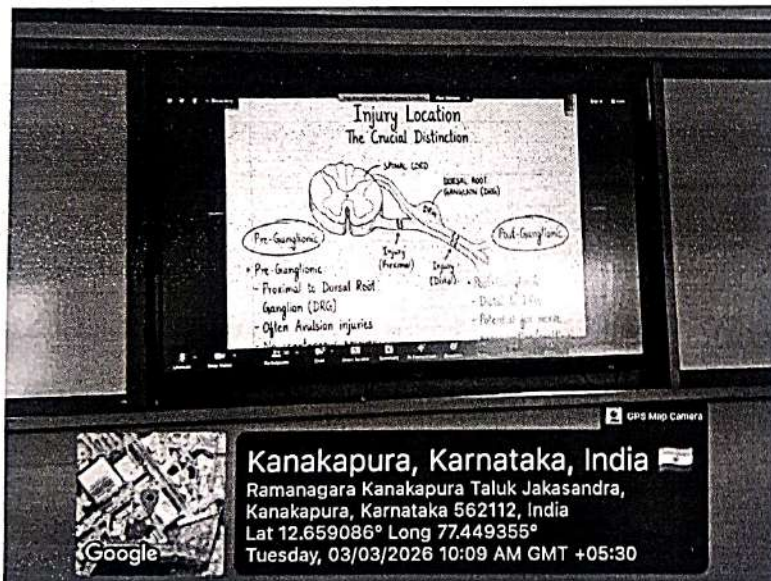
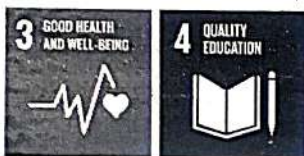
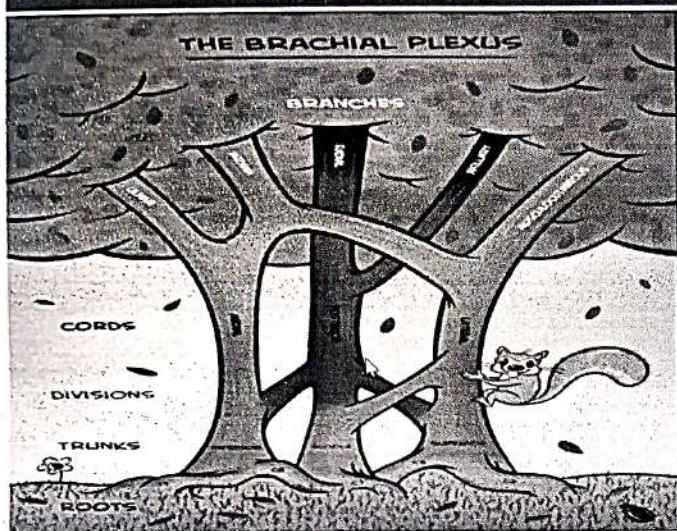


Figure 2: Dr. Chhaya Verma delivering presentation on BPI Rehabilitation



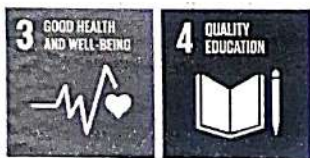
