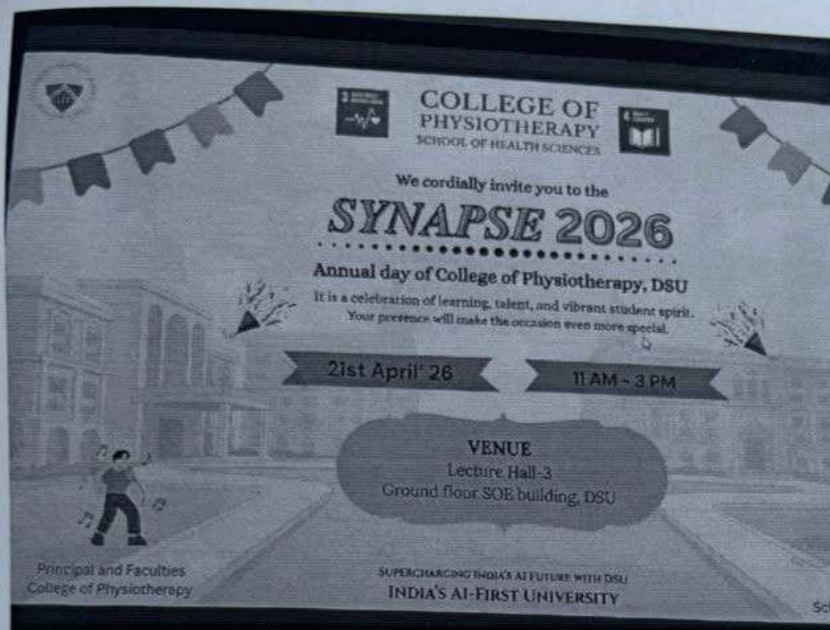


Figure 1: Lamp Lightening



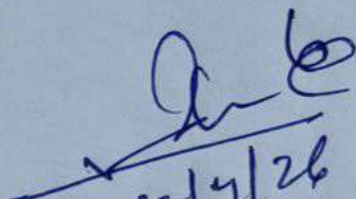
Figure 2: Dance performance by the winners

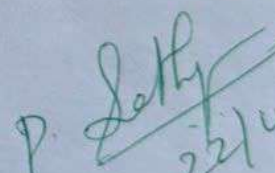
