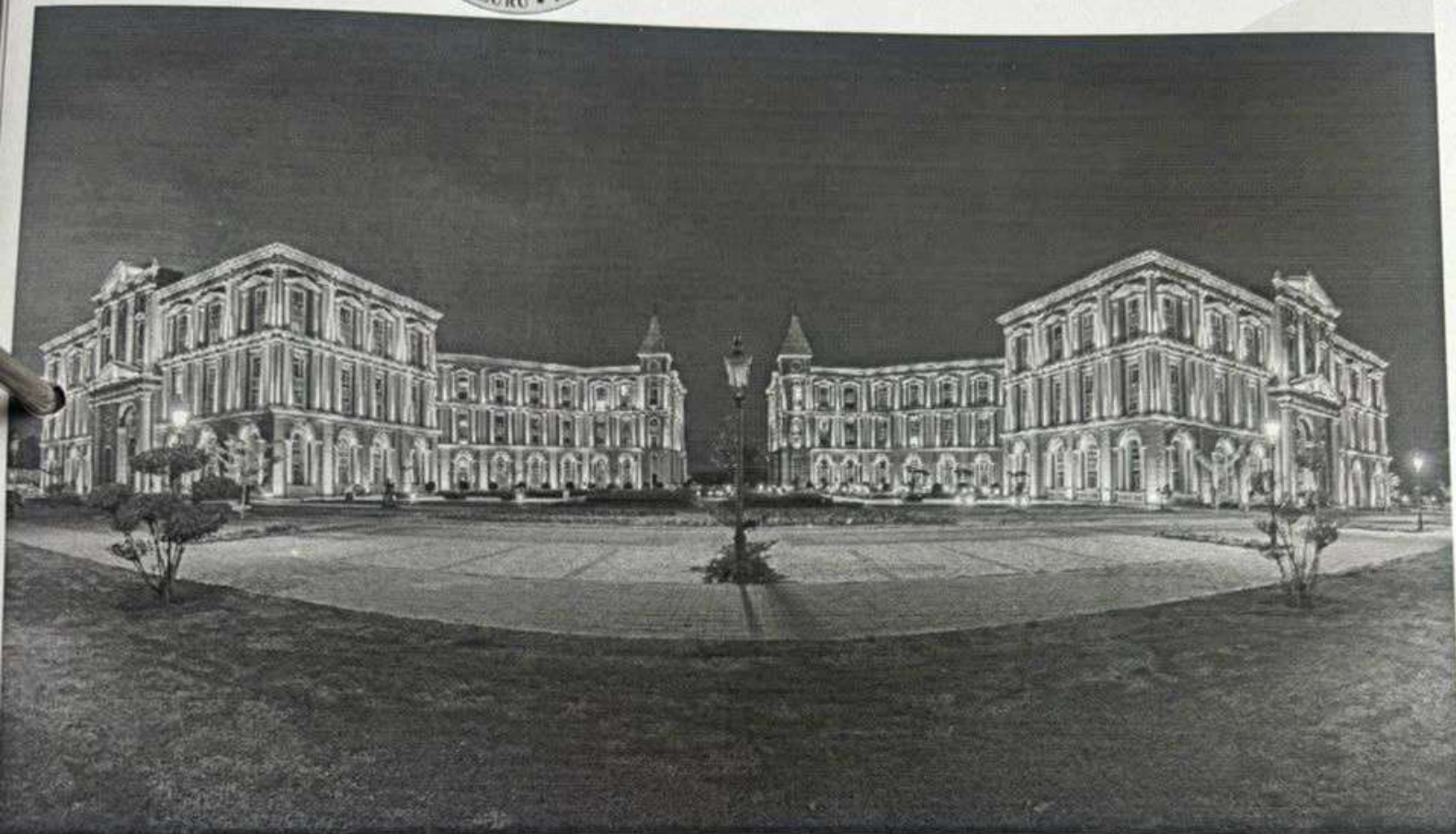

The event concluded on a positive note, highlighting leadership, enthusiasm, and the spirit of new beginnings.



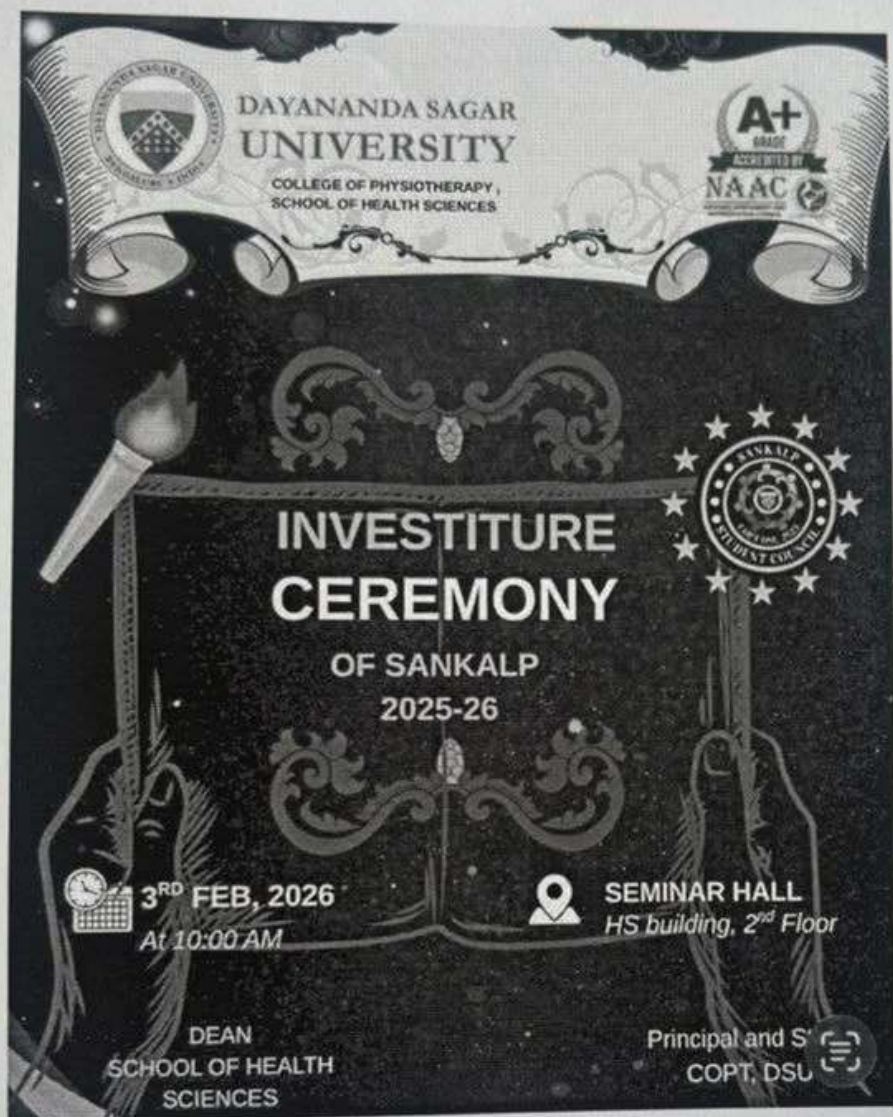


Figure 1: Batching Ceremony

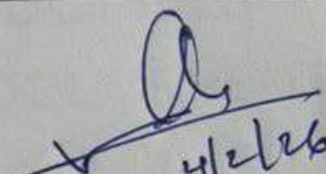

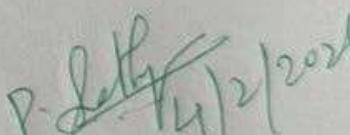
