College of Physiotherapy organized a Basic care life support program on 19-01-2023 & 20-01-2023 from the Jeeva Raksha trust associated with the Rajiv Gandhi University. The program started at 8 am with the formal inaugural function followed by the prayer, lighting of the lamp by Dinesh instructor Jeeva Raksha and staff college of physiotherapy Dayananda Sagar University. On 19-01-2023; 34 students and 2 teaching staff attended the program and on 20-01-2023; 34 students and 2 teaching staff attended the program. Basic care life support for health care professionals trained the participants to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give quality CPR, deliver appropriate compression, relieve choking and provide early use of an AED.
