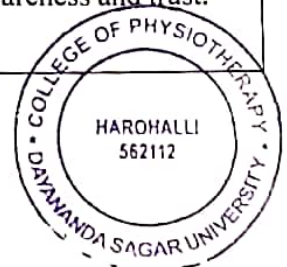

The NSS Committee of Dayananda Sagar University, in collaboration with the College of Physiotherapy, organized a meaningful Tuberculosis Awareness Campaign on 23rd April 2025, from 10:00 AM onwards, at Thokkasandra, Kanakapura. This initiative was planned under the guidance of Mrs. Jyothi, NSS Officer, and brought together a group of 15 dedicated volunteers from BPT III year who were committed to spreading awareness about Tuberculosis and promoting healthier lifestyles within rural communities.

The event began with an orientation session held at Lecture Hall-3, A Block, SOE Building, where volunteers were briefed about the objectives of the program. After the orientation, the team proceeded to Thokkasandra village where the awareness campaign took place. Volunteers engaged in door-to-door visits, directly interacting with the residents of the village. Through simple and compassionate communication, they explained essential information about Tuberculosis, including its symptoms, modes of transmission, preventive strategies, and the importance of timely diagnosis and treatment.

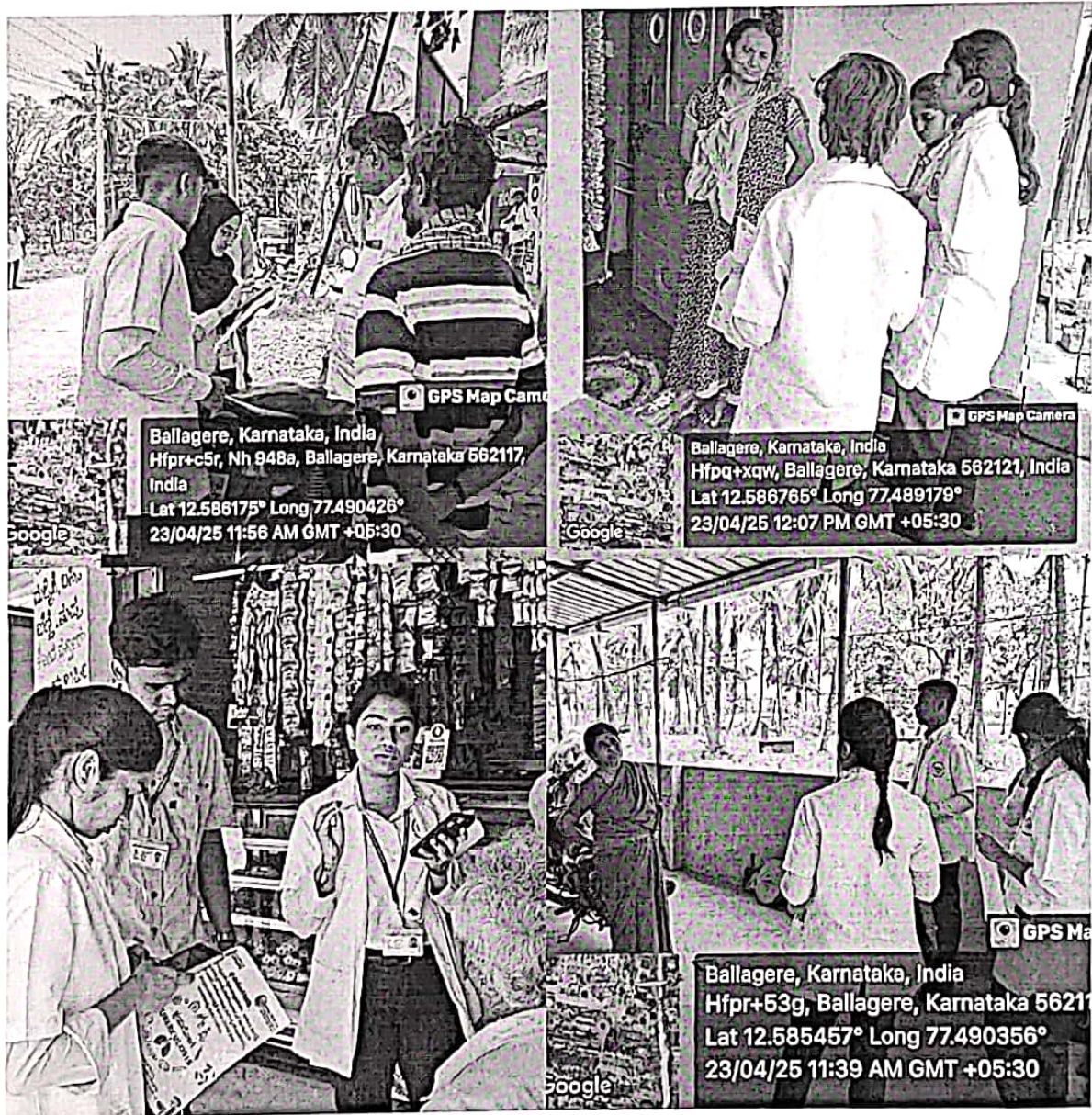
To support the verbal information and enhance understanding, visually appealing and informative pamphlets, specially designed by the College of Physiotherapy, containing easy-to-understand messages and visuals that helped convey the seriousness of TB and the steps to protect oneself and others from it. In addition to the awareness drive, a brief survey was conducted to collect valuable insights on the existing awareness levels, health history, and willingness of the villagers to seek medical assistance.

The villagers actively participated in the campaign, showing keen interest in learning about Tuberculosis and engaging in open conversations with the volunteers. The warmth and enthusiasm displayed by the community reflected the success of the program in fostering awareness and trust.



The event not only empowered the villagers with health knowledge but also provided the student volunteers, an experience in public health education and rural outreach.

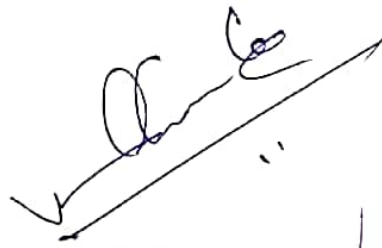

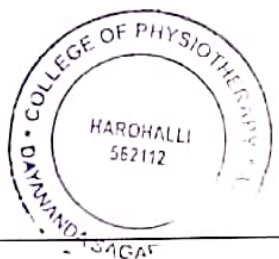


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
