
The workshop was successfully organised for 2 days where it commenced with the inaugural ceremony with Prof. B N Pranasha Rao, CPDM med TBI IISc, Bangalore as the Chief Guest who enlightened the audience with his contributions and ingenious design of chair utilised for therapy of vestibular dysfunction. This was followed by Sessions on the Anatomy and Physiology of Vestibular System by Dr. Rajesh V L.

Day 2 of the workshop commenced with the sessions on overview of various central and peripheral vestibular disorders. An extensive session was taken to delve into the subjective and objective assessment. This was followed by a hand-on practical demonstration and applications of the therapeutic approaches. This workshop proved to be an invaluable learning opportunity for healthcare professionals dedicated to improving the quality of life for patients with vestibular disorders.

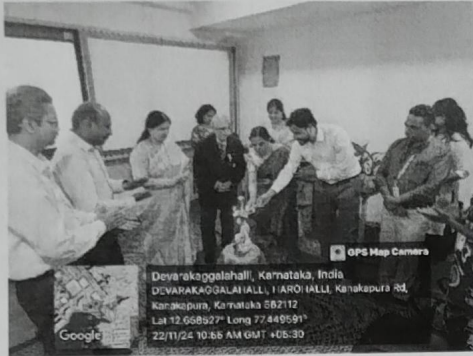
