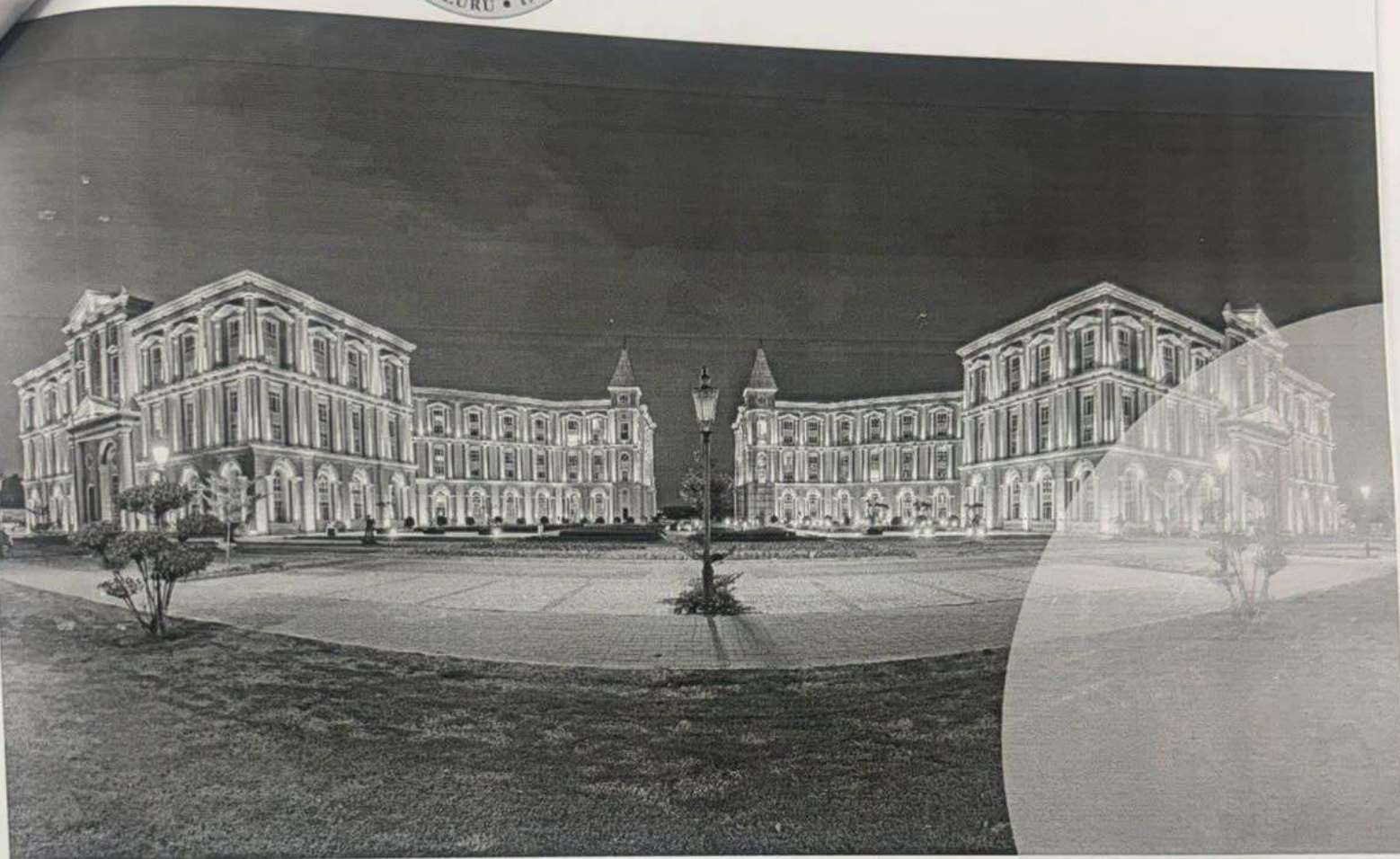

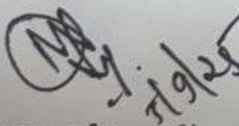


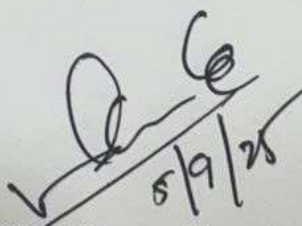
Figure 3: Orientation to sports activity

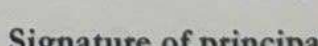

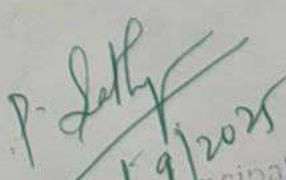
