## NSS ACTIVITIES OF DSU

### HEALTH AND HYGIENE AWARENESS:



The Department of Student Affairs conducted a National Service Scheme (NSS) awareness programme on health and hygiene at the Government School, T. Hosahalli on 26 July 2024. The event featured interactive sessions and demonstrations guiding students on daily hygiene habits and the long-term benefits of a healthy lifestyle. Additionally, a village-level survey was conducted to assess prevailing health and hygiene practices in the community.
